

HYPODERMIC SYRINGES AND NEEDLES

The only syringes and needles which may be supplied are those which are listed in Part 3 of the Drug Tariff. They may only be supplied against orders on form GP10.

Any supplies against stock order forms, GP10A will be disallowed.

SYRINGES

Two types of hypodermic syringe are allowed:

1. For use with U100 insulin
2. For use with drugs other than insulin. (The Drug Tariff calls these 'ordinary purpose')

- (1) **INSULIN** syringes - Available in three presentations.
 - a) Glass re-useable syringe - 0.5ml, 1ml, pre-set 1ml, click count 1ml.
 - b) Disposable syringe with needle - 0.3ml, 0.5ml, 1ml
 - c) Insulin Pens & Needles

All other sizes of glass syringe and any size of disposable syringe packed without a needle are **DISALLOWED**.

- (2) **ORDINARY PURPOSE** Syringes
1ml, 2ml with Luer mount supplied with two needles in a box are allowed.
(All other sizes of ordinary purpose syringe are DISALLOWED)

NEEDLES

Re-usable – See information in Part 3 of the Tariff

Disposable – for use with the Tariff glass insulin syringe and insulin pens

Sizes available are shown under Hypodermic Needles in Part 3 of the Tariff.
